MOBILE PALENGKE

- With the help of the Department of Agriculture, the city has launched the Mobile Palengke in three sites this past weekend: Bagumbayan, Ususan and Central Signal.
- This program provides accessible markets for farm-fresh goods in hopes to ease the volume of people heading to bigger markets and consequently prevent the spread of COVID-19. Social distancing will be observed.
- The markets also provide income for farmers and former ambulant vendors amid the COVID-19 crisis.
- Very soon, each barangay will have their own community market.

RELIEF DISTRIBUTION

- The city continues to treat the relief efforts in each barangay as an urgent and central component of the COVID-19 response, so our social workers and volunteers are working tirelessly.

STAY-AT-HOME
FOOD PACKS

- Reflecting the city's commitment is an increasing workforce for repacking and house-to-house distribution of food packs. Furthermore, we currently have four repacking centers.
- Each pack contains rice, canned goods, noodles, coffee, cereal drink and bottled water enough to sustain a family of five for three to four days.

- By the end of this week, City Hall hopes to have distributed stay-at-home packs to all barangays. This will signal the second round of distributions.

COVID-19 KITS

- Taguig has distributed COVID-19 kits to a total of **54,904** individuals.
- City Hall considers the COVID-19 kits as another important initiative helping vulnerable sectors. It contains face masks, hand sanitizers and vitamin C tablets, among others.
